AACR Annual Meeting 2024

The American Association for Cancer Research (AACR) is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) to provide continuing medical education activities for physicians.

AACR has designated this live activity for a maximum of **389.75** *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)*[™]. Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Other healthcare professionals, such as nurses, pharmacists, and physician assistants, may be able to use their participation at CME-designated activities to satisfy their licensing requirements. See below for more information on how to request a Certificate of Participation.

How do attendees apply for credit?

All individuals requesting continuing medical education credits must complete a CME Request for Credit Survey. The Request for Credit Survey is accessible by logging into the <u>AACR Annual Meeting 2024</u> <u>Program Planner</u> and via email. Registrants log on using their registration number and last name. Claim credit by clicking on "My Credit Cart" on top right, then "Import Sessions from Itinerary."

Who can receive CME credits for attending the meeting?

Physicians (M.D. and D.O.) can receive a CME Certificate by submitting a CME Request for Credit Survey. Non-physicians may request a <u>Certificate of Participation</u> by completing a CME Request for Credit Survey. Participation hours in this educational event may satisfy licensing requirements for certain specialties.

How do attendees apply for Maintenance of Certification points?

Participation in a CME activity enables the participant to earn American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) Maintenance of Certification (MOC) points equivalent to the number of CME credits claimed for the activity. To receive ABIM MOC, participants must complete all questions in the CME Request for Credit Survey and claim CME credit hours. Please then select "Request MOC Points Here" on the bottom right side of the screen. Once these steps are completed, AACR will submit your completion information via the ACCME's Program and Activity Reporting System for the purpose of granting MOC points.

What is the deadline for submitting a credit survey?

Evaluation surveys and CME credit requests must be received by Wednesday, May 22, 2024.
